Pilgrimage '24 – Save The Date!

This is a reminder that we are planning a local, non-residential pilgrimage this year from **Friday September 27th to Sunday 29th.** If you would like to join us on one or more of these days then

please keep them free in your diary.

On the Friday we will walk in the Cheshire plain between the churches at Gawsworth, North Rode, Eaton, Marton and Siddington with short acts of worship at some of these churches.

On the Saturday we will walk in the hills between the church in Rainow and Forest Chapel and Jenkin Chapel, likewise with acts of worship at some or all of these locations.

On each of these days, pilgrims will be more than welcome to either walk the whole day, just walk between one or two of the churches, or drive and meet us for worship.

On the Sunday we will walk from Sutton St James to St Michael's along the canal to arrive in time for our 10.00 o'clock service on what will be Michaelmas Sunday, the feast of St Michael
