

ECO-tip

When buying batteries, choose rechargeables, even though they are more expensive. They can be recharged up to 1000 times saving on energy and resources.



The only problem with rechargeable batteries is in emergency situations, as they do not hold their charge well if not being used and recharged regularly.

You should also look for batteries that are conflict-free, as with all electrical goods which use rare minerals such as lithium and nickel. Manufacturers should not access their supplies from countries or regions subject to war or violence. The minerals are often the source of the dispute.

Whichever batteries you use, do NOT put them into the black bins, they must be disposed of safely at the recycling centre or into our own bin at St Michael's by the office door.

Please add them loose and not in bags or packaging.


