NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Upgrade of audio-visual facilities comprising:

1. Installation of electric retractable projection screen behind the chancel arch, with electrical socket to power it. The screen winch to be fixed to wooden roof trusses.
2. Installation of projector mounted to the front of the west end gallery, to its north side
3. Installation of pan-tilt-zoom camera mounted to the front of west end gallery, towards its north side. Installation of fixed camera above the PTZ mount
4. Provision of Turning Leaf AV cabinet adjacent to existing AV mixing desk cabinet, to be repositioned towards the north west of the nave
5. Installation of two input sockets, one in an existing floor box at the front and one in the equipment rack.
6. Installation of HDMI and other cabling within the floor grids as much as possible. Where visible, cabling to be painted to match the background and on routes previously agreed with architect

A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter.

Directions to petitioner

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
