

See what flew into St Michael's last Saturday!

One of the rarest British birds, the Willow Tit, was the centre of attention at St Michael's last Saturday



when about 200 people gathered at a meeting organised by the RSPB and Save Danes Moss. Danes Moss is home to one of the biggest populations in Cheshire of this wonderful bird. It's a special habitat for hundreds of other species as well as a huge store of carbon packed peat



Next week's concert is on Thursday 28th March, and is a piano recital by Wendy Nugent, a graduate of the Royal Academy of Music. She will be playing works by Bach, Mozart, Mendelssohn, Liszt and Chopin.
